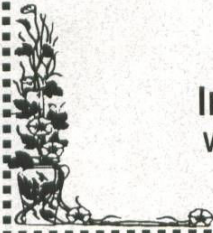

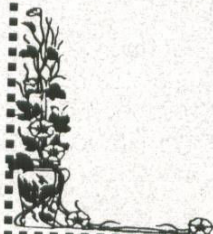


Eulogy
