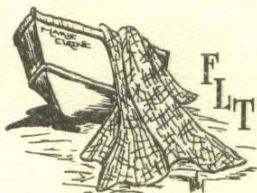

NOVEMBER 18, 1917 - MARCH 31, 1992

Today we are all gathered here to pay tribute, mourn and say our final farewell — each in our own way — to Felix Turbe, loving husband, father, grandfather and friend.
