### EULOGY

He never shared much of his personal life with anyone and although a loving person was never a family man.*

*"Doc" made friends easily and helped out wherever he went and was even willing to do chores no one else wanted to do. He was a hard worker. Whether in activities in French Town or Church events he was there helping. When he became a member of the French Town Evangelistic Assembly, he got involved in those areas of church work where he was out of the lime light. He volunteered to help clean the Sanctuary and helped direct parking. At church, he made sure no one parked in the Pastor's space and was kind of an overseer as to what took place around the parameters of the Church. He was not a "churchy type" but respected the leadership and what the building was designed for.*

*In 2005, Uncle Doc became ill and many thought that this was the end, but because of his faith and the results of the prayers of many, he regained his health and continued to the end. He will be missed in French Town very much. The bay side will never be the same without him there. The many inquiries over the past three months attest to the concern many people had for him.
