John Alfredo Elesow was born on December 2, 1936 in Frenchtown, St. Thomas, Virgin Islands. He was the son of the late Marie A. Magras of St. Thomas and James E. Elesow of Fredericksted, St. Croix, VI

At the very early age of 13, John mastered the art of fishing and worked with his grandfather, Gustave (One Hand) Magras for a number of years as a means of earning a livelihood. He then held several jobs in the private sector and later was employed by the VI Department of Agriculture.

His early interest in western folklore, cowboy movies and country and western music soon earned him the nickname of "Panhandle" as he became known to his many friends. To his grandfather and a few closer friends he was called "Mapoon."

John married Mary Rose Aubain on December 22, 1958. An avid baseball fan, his favorite team was the New York Mets, whose progress he monitored very closely on radio and TV. His love of fishing never waned, and often he could be seen along with Rose and Emma heading west in search of the Jacks.

In 1992, John was struck with Cancer. He battled this monster for a period of eight years. There were periods of improvement, and through it all John fought hard, with his wife Rose at his side, assisting in every way possible.

Then, on September 2, 2000, it was time for John's suffering to end when the Master summoned him home to a better place. He will be missed by his family and friends.
