Eulogy

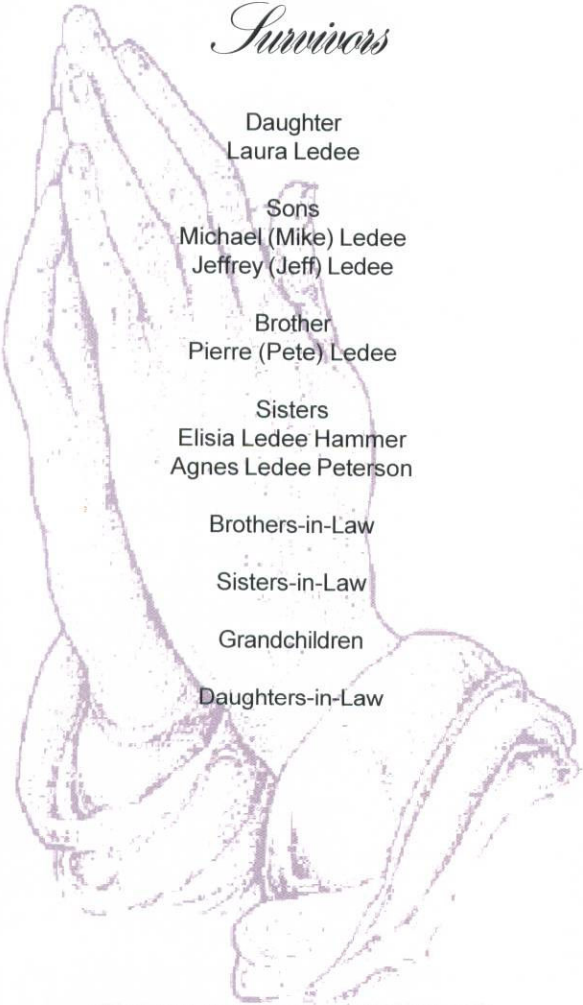
