John Timothy Dungan was the second of six children born to Rose and Paul Dungan in El Paso, Texas, where he lived most of his childhood. After graduating from high school in Texas, he came to St. Thomas to live with his mother, his step father, and his siblings.

A few years later he met and married Sherry Turbe and they have two sons from that marriage. Thursday, November 29th was their 22nd wedding anniversary.

John worked at the airport for several years with Eastern Metro and Eagle airlines and later he went to work at the Virgin Islands Bureau of Internal Revenue as an Excise Tax Officer. It was there he discovered his love for computers and became quite skilled at fixing them.

Even after he became disabled, many friends would come to his home to have him look at their computer. John suffered all his life from diabetes and became downhearted the last few years neglecting his health and then suffering the consequences. He began to suffer with arthritis in his hands making it hard to work on the computers and this further depressed him.

In October he went into a coma and when he came out of it nine days later he was not himself. After six weeks in the hospital he was released and in the last two weeks we watched as he slipped further and further away from his family. Although he wasn't talking much to anyone, when Father Mark came to bless him on Friday, he told Father "IT'S ABOUT TIME". Father was taken aback but he continued his praying to which John echoed "Amen".

We will miss John and the rooms full of computers, but we are happy he is out of his suffering and we know he has gone home to the Father. Rest in Peace, John.
