Eulogy

Joseph Emelien Blanchard was born on March 23, 1919 to Marie Virginia and Augustin Rafael Blanchard on the island of St.Barths in the French West Indies. On July 10, 1941 he came to St.Thomas.

He married Agatha Quetel on October 11, 1942. She bore him two children – Catherine (deceased) and Ralph Blanchard. Knowing that his closest ties were here in St. Thomas he decided that this was where he belonged and on September 21, 1959 he became a U. S. Citizen.

He worked for many years for the Virgin Islands Government in the Department of Public Works as a Carpenter until a serious injury forced him into an early retirement.

On October 15th he died after a brief illness at the St.Thomas Hospital. Fond memories will forever dwell in our minds and hearts because of Emelien. May he rest in peace.
