Josephine Magras was employed by the Senior Community Service Employment Program since June 13, 1977 until her illness in 1988. She was employed as a Companion Aide. Her assignment included daily visits to the shut-ins in the Frenchtown Community. She also did light shopping and carried messages between the shut-ins.

She was a warm and friendly person. Her life has touched many - - young and old - - and she will be missed, especially by those she became close with.

Josephine went to meet her Sweet Savior with the comfort of knowing that she did the best she could in life for everyone around her. She was blessed with an "A-1" husband, Guillaume, better known as "Ming", who adored her and showered her with love for thirty-two (32) wonderful years, sacrificing everything, including his job for the seven months that she was ill to make sure she gets the best care.
