Paul Lawrence Aubain was born on August 11, 1959 to Paul and Bernadette Aubain. He was known to many as "Larry". He resided in Contant with his mom, Nadette, always caring for her with great concern.

Paul attended S.S. Peter and Paul Grammar and High School, graduating in 1977.

During 1979-1988 Paul worked with the V.I. Water and Power Authority as a Power Plant Operator.

In December 1988, Paul enlisted with the U.S. Navy and was stationed on board the USS Detroit. He was assigned to the Engineering Department Main Propulsion and Auxiliary Division until 1992. While serving in Operation Desert Shield and Desert Storm, Paul was awarded numerous Medals including:

Upon completion of his tour, Paul did another four years with the Naval Reserve and was honorably discharge in 1996.

Paul leaves behind his only child, Paul Jr., who was born on December 30, 1983, and his granddaughter, Avanel. Although they were miles apart, Paul had them in his thoughts and spoke of them often.

The passion for cars, the beach, playing pool and just being among his friends and family contented Paul. He always had a great sense of humor and was never at loss for words.

Paul was close with his family, especially his mom and sisters. He formed a special bond between Olivia and himself since her recent arrival back home. Paul relied on her tremendously during the past few months as his health declined. He also knew he had the love and support of his entire family, friends, and neighbors.

Paul died at a young age, but he has left all who knew him an abundance of love and fond memories.
