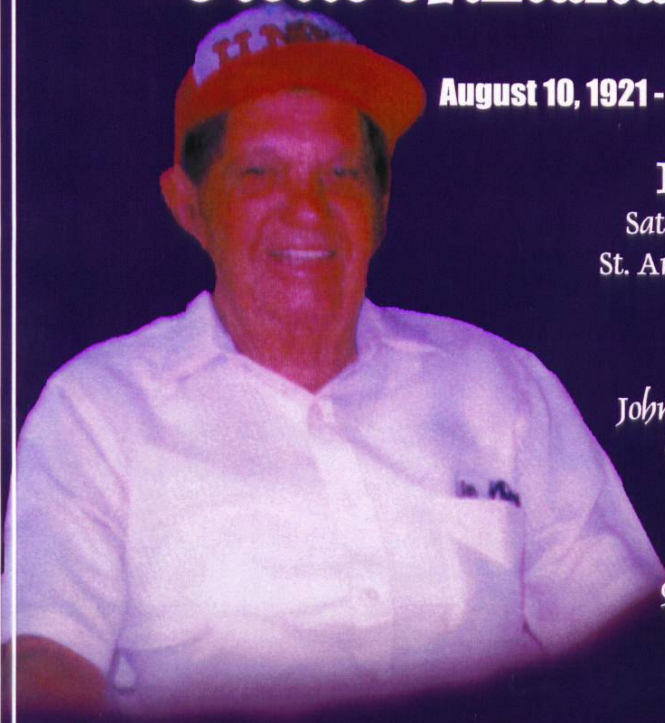

PIERRE ALMANDO MAGRAS

Nineteen years ago, when our mother and grandmother, Bernadette, passed away she was described as "the flower growing in the shadow of a rock whose seeds have been scattered by the wind into the four corners of the valley". Today we are gathered here to pay our last respects to that "Rock" of our family.

PIERRE ALMANDO MAGRAS, affectionately known as "Mondo" was born on August 10th and had recently turned eighty. He was the eldest of six children born to Pierre and Henrietta Magras and his early life involved having to leave school after sixth grade to work to help in the support of his siblings.

ALMANDO was a founding member of the Frenchtown Civic Organization in 1955 and a past president. He was selected Father of the Year in 1964 and served with the Sea Explorers adult committee for 25 years. A life-long Democrat, he was very active in his early years lobbying politicians for infrastructure for Frenchtown. He was employed as an accountant with Pan American World Airways for over 22 years and took advantage of one of the perks of his job by traveling far and often. In 1972 he traveled around the world with his wife of 41 years.

MONDO was preceded in death earlier this year by his eldest son, Gene, and is survived by sons Stanley and Cain and two daughters Marianne and Beverly, seventeen grandchildren and thirteen great grandchildren, a special sister, Florie, sister-in-law, Tris and many other relatives and friends.

Now it is time to say goodbye, Daddy, but we know that you are safe in the embrace of our Savior Jesus Christ. We are a strong family because we are all a part of you, so, before we say goodbye we want to say thank you, Dad.
