Pierre Julien Danet

Pierre Julien Danet was born on St. Thomas on June 8, 1926 to the late Mederic and Marie Danet. His formative years was spent on St. Thomas where he was raised by Lucina Danet. In 1947, he married Theresa "Terry" Danet, a union which produced one daughter, Gail Danet-Joseph. After marrying Terry some 56 years ago this month, Pierre moved to New York where he took up employment at the Sheraton Hotel. While there, he enlisted in the United States Army for two years before returning home in 1954. Back on St. Thomas, Pierre opned and operated the infamous "Pierre's Diner." Still not content with that employment opportunity, he joined the Virgin Islands National Bank, one of the island's premier banking institutions wich later became First Pennsylvania Bank and subsequently Corestates First Pennsylvania Bank. After 32 years of service, he retired in 1987. He spent his remaining years at home.

A lover of sports, he was an avid New York Yankees fan. Here at home, Pierre is remembered as a manager and coach of several softball teams. He was also involved in both the promotion and advancement of the sport of local boat racing.

Pierre will also be remembered for the assistance he rendered to various home owners as he worked diligently in the 1960's to make home ownership a reality for those who today occupy Estate Honduras on the backside of Frenchtown, overlooking the East Gregorie Channel. He is also remembered as a member of the choir at St. Anne's Chapel, in fact, among the choir's first soloists. Pierre's distinguished voice could be heard at Christmas time leading the choir in the rendition of the longtime favorite, "In Old Judea."

Pierre had the good fortune to see his only daughter marry SFC Trevor M. Joseph, a union which has yielded one grand-daughter, Takia Theresa Rhoda Joseph.

Pierre's health began to deteriorate at the turn of the century in the year 2000. Terry, Gail, his care taker Jean Quetel and family and friends who would stop by, provided for him in his remaining days in this life. He died peacefully on Saturday, November 22 at his beloved home. We pray that his soul and the souls of the faithful departed rest in peace.
